| Crazy Science Experiments | As part of the early learner curriculum, this science class introduces young learners to the basic foundations of discovery, hypothesis, and science fun. | Monday 10-10:55 | \$150/semester \$300/year |
| Introduction to Fine Arts | Everyone is an artist of some kind, and Intro to Visual Fine Art believes in revealing the artist within! One of the best ways to encourage artistic development is through exposure to a wide variety of art mediums, as well as the exploration of various techniques and applications. Students are introduced to the elements of art (line, shape, color, texture, value, form, space) and principles of design (balance, contrast, emphasis, movement, pattern, rhythm, unity). These concepts are the foundation to understanding and executing all types of visual art. Students can expect to explore a wide variety of art media such as acrylic and watercolor paint, chalk and oil pastels, air dry and ceramic clay, creating take-home "masterpieces." | Monday 11- 11:55 | \$150/semester \$300/year |
| Improv Theater | Introduction to Fine Arts with Improv theater give students the opportunity to learn communication skills important to everyday life, from speaking at meetings to interviewing for a job! This course will help students develop better vocal projection, stronger body positioning, better reading skills, better vocal expression, stronger memorization skills, and overall confidence in presenting. Students will learn creative movement, body positioning, verbal and nonverbal communication skills, vocal projection, script writing, improvisation, and teambuilding. | Language Arts K-2 | This course is designed to make Aesop's Fables come alive through exciting, hands---on projects. Each week's lesson will focus on a different fable, and students will complete writing, comprehension, and art activities for each story to put in their fable portfolio. We will examine the elements of story, learn to identify the moral and its meaning within a fable, and improve reading comprehension. At the end of the semester, students will write an original "fable" and create a storybook of their own. | Monday 12:30-1:25 | \$150/semester \$300/year |
| Math K-2 | Concepts include counting, writing and reading numbers, place value, addition and subtraction, money, graphs, measurement, time, temperature, and fractions. Applications to real-world situations and daily "Thinking Caps" stretch students' thinking ability. The work-text includes classwork and seatwork (independent) pages for every day based on the themes of the zoo, ocean, farm, and springtime. | Monday 1:30-2:25 | \$150/semester \$300/year |
